All sheep need a shepherd. They have no defenses. They can’t compete. They can’t bite, kick or run. They don’t see well. They get stickers in their fur. We need a shepherd to feed and protect us. Even our shepherds need shepherds! And.....there is an enemy loose! John10:10, he wants to steal kill and destroy God’s flock and plans. Read the whole chapter slowly. Find where you are now.....an elder, a pastor, a momma with lambs, a young person in the Lord learning to follow His voice. Sheep have to walk.....and live peacefully to be well and stay whole.....just like us. All sheep have to listen for The Shepherds voice, even....especially the “elder sheep”, who lead the flock too. Some verses instruct us on our personal responsibility as a sheep, but we are also instructed to stay in right relationship with God, and safe from the devil, who seeks whom he may destroy and who roars like a lion.
